TP SUNDAY IS JUNE 30

FIT is collecting toilet paper for the Christ Woodland Food Pantry. It serves nearly 200 people each month, and is open every Wednesday from 10:00 a.m.—Noon, at 444 N. Hawkins. Along with fresh fruit, the pantry tries to provide things that SNAP (the federal supplemental nutrition assistance program) does not cover.



Here's a look at what you can and cannot buy with a SNAP card.

A Snapshot of SNAP

What you can buy	What you cannot buy with SNAP
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fruits and vegetables; • Meat, poultry, & fish; • Dairy products; • Breads & cereals; • Other foods (i.e.—snack foods and non-alcoholic beverages) • Seeds & plants, which produce food 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alcoholic beverages • Tobacco products • Vitamins, medicines, & supplements. • Live animals (except shellfish, fish, and animals slaughtered prior to pick-up from the store). • Foods that are hot at the point of sale • Any nonfood items for humans such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Pet foods •Cleaning supplies, paper products, & other household supplies •Hygiene items, cosmetics

Please try to bring in toilet paper or diapers or baby wipes. They also need food items like peanut butter, canned chicken, or tuna. *Thank you for supporting our neighborhood!*
